What Will I Learn?

This program is designed to prepare students to perform the duties and responsibilities required by entry level positions in the welding trade, such as Welder, Arc Welder, or Combination Welder. This program includes instruction in arc welding, resistance welding, brazing and soldering, cutting, high energy beam welding & cutting, solid state welding, ferrous and non-ferrous materials, oxidation-reduction reactions, welding metallurgy, welding processes and heat treating, structural design, safety, and applicable codes and standards. Students will also learn about welding shop safety, shop math, blue print reading, shop English, and study the SMAW process, the Oxy-Fuel process, the GTAW process, the GMAW process, and the FCAW process. Learning about all the above processes, will include becoming familiar with the tools, materials, equipment, and setup, as well as getting experience in each area.
