## What Will I Learn?

Students will be introduced to the procedures and skills found in the truck driving industry as well as the high demand jobs in agriculture commodity. Individuals will develop the skills necessary to operate a commercial vehicle safely and will receive in-depth instruction that goes beyond just learning to obtain a license. This course consists of classroom, lab, range and on-the-road experience, to ensure the BEST possible training. The program covers topics in basic operations, safe operating practices, advanced operating practices, vehicle maintenance, non-vehicle activities and includes opportunities to work with live freight. This program meets the minimum requirements established by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA).

## **Program Objective:**

Upon completion of this program, students will have the basic knowledge and practical skills necessary to become a proficient entry-level truck driver. They will be prepared to obtain a Commercial Driver License which can include the following: Air-Brakes, Combinations, **Doubles-Triples, Tankers, and Hazardous Materials (Per Federal** Regulations, additional criteria must be met to be approved for Haz-Mat).

## **Transporting Cargo:**

Students will gain "real world" experience with hands-on-training, in our freight division. This training is incorporated in the curriculum for all Ag Transportation students. This program provides a day in the life, hands-on snap shot of a typical truck driver. This program is ONLY available to our Ag Transportation students. Students will accompany our freight drivers on an actual truck driving run, and obtain additional knowledge in the following areas: Load Securement, Log Books, CHP Weigh Stations, Mountain driving with a live load, Driving in congested traffic, Loading/Unloading procedures, as well as many other activities.

## **Career Opportunities:**

Upon completion from this course, the student will be able to obtain work in entry-level truck driver positions with common carriers, private truck fleets, local, short and long haul companies.
